- Make sure sidewalks are shoveled and clear in winter; could introduce by-law where owners are fined if they don't shovel sidewalk within a certain time; make programs available to seniors to get help when they need shoveling, yard work done.

- At least maintain the services currently available in French;
- As our seniors become more fragile and vulnerable, will need more services, specifically more long term care;
- As this group of seniors becomes more fragile may need more accessible transportation.
