NFAMC has the mandate to support and assist the ethno-cultural and newcomer community in Niagara through a broad range of programs and services.

This includes client needs assessments, information and referrals, orientation, assistance completing forms, accompanying clients to appointments, one-to-one supportive counselling, interpretation/translation services, employment-related services and supports, and workshops and information sessions.
