The entrance to the dwelling must be one that can be used without passing through the living quarters of some other person or group of persons.			
3	Private dwellings occupied by usual residents			
	A private dwelling occupied by usual residents refers to a private dwelling in which a person or a group of persons is permanently residing. Also included are private dwellings whose usual residents are temporarily absent on May 11 2021.			
4	The category 'Movable dwelling' includes mobile homes and other movable dwellings such as houseboats recreational vehicles and railroad cars.
