## **Unmet Needs – Niagara January to December 2016**

R As a general practice, 211 Information and Referral Specialists document situations where no referrals were available to meet an inquirer's assessed need. The situations captured in this report are intended to inform communities of potential gaps in service within our human service provision.

During the reporting period of January to December 2016, a total of **36,379** inquiries came from within Niagara. **471 Unmet Needs were documented from Niagara**.

Difficulty Connecting (35)	<ul> <li>Trying to contact Ontario Works to inquire about coverage – worker has not returned call</li> <li>Busy signal on multiple attempts to connect to the following services: transportation services, distress lines (mental health and addictions), recreation information lines, medical information line, legal aid, employment insurance, seniors support services, government services</li> <li>Unable to locate contact information for new service</li> </ul>
